### **March is Fraud Prevention Month**

Scams are everywhere these days, and fraudsters are using more sophisticated tactics to target people of all ages. At Stride, we take your security seriously and are always working to protect our members from financial fraud. Whether it's spotting common scams, securing your accounts, or sharing the latest fraud prevention tips,

we're here to keep you informed and one step ahead.

In case you missed it, we've been sharing fraud prevention tips on <u>social media</u> this month. Here are some of the top ways to protect yourself:

#### **Beware of Impersonation Fraud**

Follow these tips to protect yourself:

- Verify unexpected calls: If you receive a call asking for personal information or money, hang up and call back using a legitimate number from the official website.
- Ignore suspicious texts and emails asking for personal info or money. Legitimate organizations will **not** ask for sensitive details this way.



 Protect your security codes: Never share one-time passcodes or MFA codes with anyone.

#### Protect your passwords

Your passwords are personal! Never share them with anyone. If someone is asking for your password, it's a scam. Stride Credit Union will NEVER ask for your login password—not by phone, email, or text.

Protect your passwords by using strong, unique passwords for each of your accounts.



#### E-Transfer Scams


Look out for these common e-transfer scams:

- "Overpayment" scams when selling items online.
- Urgent requests from friends or family.
